

**COMMERCIAL CIRCULAR LETTER NO.62 of 2018
DRAFT NOTIFICATION FOR TRC NO. 03 of 2018
(GOODS)**

- Sub:** Uniform working hours and business hours for railway goods shed/siding – incentive for extended working hours and immediate removal of goods.
Ref: 1) Railway Board's Ir.no.TC-I/2018/201/1 dt. 12.03.18 addressed to FA&CAO (T), WR.
2) Rates Master Circular/Demurrage-Wharfage-Waiver/2016/0 dt.12.03.18.

Railway Board, vide Para 4.0 of Rates Master Circular/Demurrage-Wharfage-Waiver/2016/0 dated 12.03.2018, issued guidelines regarding 50% incentive during night working hours.

Now, Railway Board, vide letter no. TC-I/2018/201/1 dt. 12.03.18, addressed to FA&CAO (T)/ WR, has reiterated that the provision for reckoning only 50% of the time during extended night working hours (i.e. beyond 22.00 hours) as free time has been introduced as an incentive to gradually motivate rail customers as well as zonal railways towards "round-the-clock" working over all railway terminals, with a view to reduce detention of rolling stock and to improve wagon-turn-round.


Policy guidelines contained in Rates Master Circular have been issued with the concurrence of Finance Dte. of Railway Board, Para 4.3 to 4.5 of the same hold good. However, in the illustration (3) of Annexure 'B' of the said circular, there is inadvertent calculation error in demurrage time. It should be read as 08 hours instead of 06 hours (refer enclosure).

This issues with the concurrence of Finance Dte. of Ministry of Railways.

These guidelines shall be implemented for the rakes placed after 00.00 hrs of 20.03.2018.

"Staff in the field units should read the instructions carefully and understand the same, thoroughly. Thereafter, the instructions should be implemented. In case of any doubts, letters may be addressed to the respective Sr.DCMs with copy to PCCM's Office"


